Author Event-Fighting Prosaic Messages

In 2010, Henry C Amoroso Jr., a noted literacy advocate and USM professor, passed away. Prior to his death, he completed *Fighting Prosaic Messages*, a personal history and scholarly look at literacy teaching in America. In it, he follows his grandmother's experience immigrating from Italy to Massachusetts, her own struggles with literacy, the literacy challenges faced by her son, by the author, and his children.

Part historical fiction, part memoir, part philosophy of education, this book offers a critique of the U.S. education system.
