

PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

TOWN OF GORHAM

In order to protect our residents and employees and to help prevent the spread of diseases such as the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and Seasonal Flu to people in your home and community, we ask that you follow the CDC guidelines listed below.

COVID-19 and/or the seasonal flu may present the following symptoms:

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath

If you are sick with COVID-19, or suspect you have the COVID-19 virus, stay home except to get medical care.

You should restrict activities outside your home, except for getting medical care.

DO NOT GO TO WORK, SCHOOL, OR PUBLIC AREAS SUCH AS THE TOWN HALL, LIBRARY, AND OTHER PUBLIC BUILDINGS. AVOID USING PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, RIDE-SHARING, OR TAXIS.
