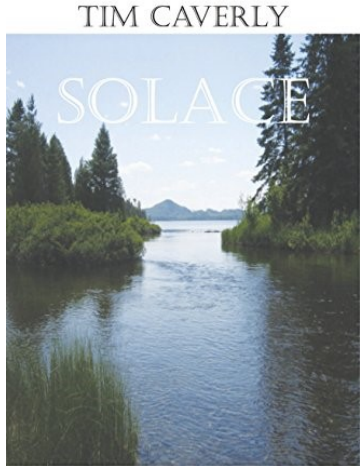

Start saving those pennies, nickels, dimes and quarters because the ARLGP is throwing its second annual LOOSE CHANGE CHALLENGE!

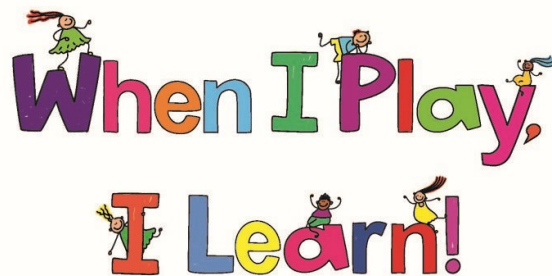

Play to Learn Workshops
March 13th-April 10th 10am



Baxter Memorial Library is offering another round of our Play-to-Learn Workshop on Fridays, March 13th-April 10th. This workshop consists of 5 sessions in which 8 families, with children ages 0-3, visit the library on Fridays from 10-11:15am. During each session we will have a different community professional join our play time. We plan on hosting a speech pathologist, an occupational therapist, and a social worker. This is your opportunity to meet child development professionals in a relaxed, low-key environment and ask them any questions you may have. We set up the room with toys that are specifically reserved for our Play-to-Learn workshops and also offer a different art experience each week. Space is limited so call the library at 222-1190 if you want to be part of this experience. We ask that you are able to commit to at least 4 of these sessions.
