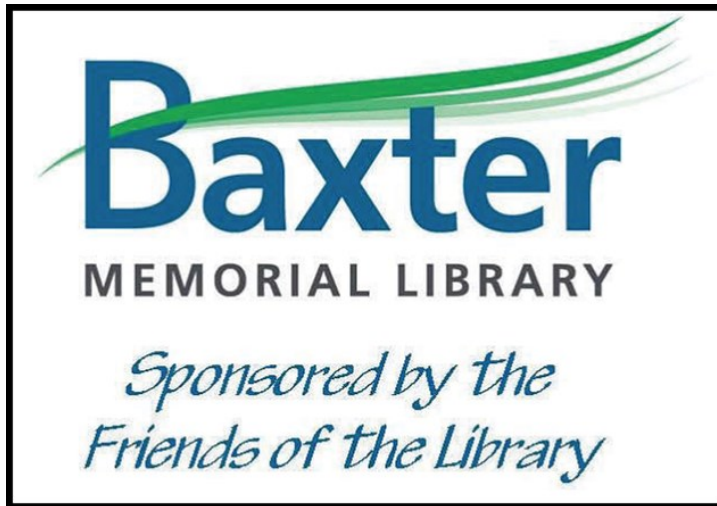




# MARCH GREETINGS FROM BAXTER MEMORIAL LIBRARY!
