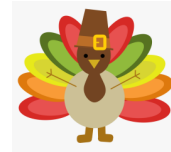


November Greetings from Baxter Memorial Library!!

Join us to hear local author, educator, classicist, and tattoo artist Phuc Tran speak! Phuc's memoir, *Sigh, Gone: A Misfit's Memoir of Great Books, Punk Rock, and the Fight to Fit In* was published in 2020. Born in Sài Gòn Việt Nam, his family fled to America in 1975, and he grew up in Carlisle PA. Reared on a steady diet of Saturday morning cartoons, John Hughes, Star Wars, Bones Brigade videos, and bootlegged cassettes of *Minor Threat* and *TSOL*, he graduated high school in 1991. He majored in Classical Languages and Literature at Bard College, got his Master's Degree at University of Massachusetts Amherst, and then moved to New York City in 1997. There he apprenticed to be a tattoo artist while teaching Latin during the day, and he's been teaching and tattooing ever since.

Bruce Robert Coffin is the award-winning author of the bestselling Detective Byron mystery series. A former detective sergeant with more than twenty-seven years in law enforcement, he supervised all homicide and violent crime investigations for Maine's largest city. Following the terror attacks of September 11, 2001, Bruce spent four years investigating counter-terrorism cases for the FBI, earning the Director's Award, the highest award a non-agent can receive.
