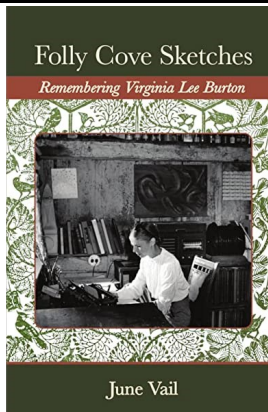

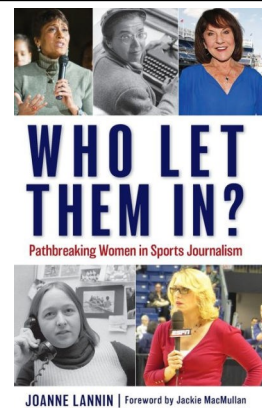
Author Event

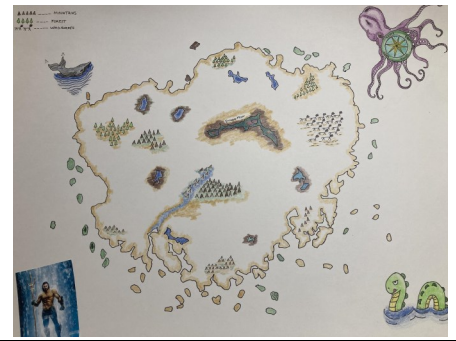
